



JOB OPPORTUNITIES IN CANADA

Employers and government immigration officials from the Canadian province of Manitoba visit Lisbon this month to recruit skilled workers for full-time jobs in Manitoba, Canada.

Attendance is by invitation only. Qualified candidates will be interviewed for employment with Manitoba companies in construction, trades and other skilled occupations. These jobs can earn you Canadian permanent resident status.

The recruitment event is held by the Manitoba Government's provincial nominee program (MPNP) and Manitoba's business and Portuguese communities, with the co-operation of the Instituto do Emprego e Formação Profissional (IEFP).



To be selected for an interview:

You must have education, work experience, good English skills, a Portuguese passport and be eligible for a Canadian work visa.

ABOUT THE MPNP

The Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program works with local employers to recruit skilled workers to meet labour market demand.

After six months of work, visiting workers are eligible for Canadian permanent residence through the MPNP.
